

SCHOLARSHIPS

Music scholarships are available for full-time students majoring in music. Amounts range up to one-half tuition per year and are based upon performance ability, as exhibited in an audition before a faculty committee, and academic record. The scholarships may be renewed for up to four years when students maintain a B average in music classes, perform in two ensembles, and make steady improvement in the major applied area.

Non-major music grants of \$1,500 are available for qualified students willing to perform in two or more ensembles and take private lessons on their instrument. These scholarships also are renewable for four years on the recommendation of the ensemble directors. Recipients of choral ensemble grants are expected to enroll in Voice Class during the first semester in lieu of private voice lessons.
